PROGRAM BACKGROUND

The program offers designed and enhanced technical business and administration skills to aid our Underrepresented Business Enterprises (UBE), not just to startup but to sustain through the storm of our economic fluctuations.

Turner's School of Construction Management (TSCM) is a 6-week program that expands opportunities for growing businesses. Each course is taught by Turner staff and select industry partners. The program has helped participants enhance business acumen, build networks, and form long-term business relationships. We provide our community with the education and tools to work successfully within the industry by introducing a series of lectures in Procurement, Estimating, Contracts, Accounting, Insurance, HR, and other construction areas beneficial to a company's quality and growth. Participants are issued a certificate of completion at the end of the program.
