- Read RFPs carefully and do not leave anything out in your response
- Check SAM.gov and the DOE Forecast site regularly for upcoming opportunities to plan for and/or propose across the DOE Cleanup Sites and National Laboratories




# DOE's 17 national laboratories tackle critical scientific challenges






## What we buy and how we buy it

- PNNL purchases a VERY broad spectrum of goods and services through three purchasing mechanisms:
  - Subcontracts/Purchase Orders high-risk/high dollar goods and services; \$515M in FY22
  - P-Card low dollar goods (< \$5K) and services (<\$2,500); \$27M FY22
  - B2B Commercial Off-The-Shelf goods (<\$35,000) via eCommerce; \$12M in FY22
- PNNL supports DOE's small business objectives
- Typical Purchases include scientific & laboratory equipment; energy & efficiency resources; security software systems and products; computational tools and information technology services; construction and facilities infrastructure equipment



## Tips for working with PNNL

- Prior to Award/doing work with PNNL, you should:
  - Take a few minutes to learn about PNNL and how you can help its mission
  - Become familiar with Battelle's <u>Prime Contract</u> with the DOE for contract scope and requirements
  - Reach out to PNNL's Small Business Program Manager to express interest and submit your Capability Statement/Line Card
  - Register in PNNL's <u>Acquisition Supplier Portal</u> (ASP)
    - ✓ ASP approved profile required for onsite construction
  - Partner with a small business (if large)





## Tips for working with PNNL

- Prior to Award/doing work with PNNL (continued)
  - Become familiar with the requirements for vendor setup
    - ✓ SAM UEI # required
    - ✓ Registration in PNNL's Vendor Database and System for Award Management (SAM) or expect to fill out a MOSRC form
- Solicitation/Request for Proposal
  - Competitive solicitations posted externally >\$250K



#### **About WRPS**







- U.S. Department of Energy Office of River Protection's Prime Contractor for Hanford Tank Operations since 10/01/2008 (10-year contract plus five extension years. expires FY 23.)
- An Amentum led company with partners: Atkins and Orano, employing 2,200+ employees.



#### **Our Mission at WRPS**

- Protect the public and the environment from the risk posed by 56 million gallons of radioactive and chemical waste stored in 177 tanks. The tank waste material are remains from years of World War II and post-war production of nuclear weapons.
- Safely manage and retrieve waste from tanks and prepare the delivery system for the Waste Treatment Plant. These tanks are stored in 18 farms around the Hanford Site.
- Immobilize the waste at the Waste Treatment Plant.







### **WRPS' Strategic Priorities FY23**

## Role of the Small Business Program Manager (SBPM)

- Serve as liaison for acquisition information, vendor registration, and buyer groups.
- Provide counseling, guidance & referrals to vendors.
- Ensure that small businesses are provided the maximum opportunity to compete for subcontracted work.
- Meet or exceed established goals for awards to small businesses for the following socio-economic categories:
  - Overall Small Business 58.2%
  - Small Disadvantaged 6.3%
  - Women-Owned 5.8%
  - HUBZone 2.2%
  - Veteran-Owned 1.3%
  - Service-Disabled Veteran Owned 1.3%



As of FY22, WRPS has awarded a total of \$2,585M in subcontracts, of which \$1,677M (64.9%) is to small businesses.



#### **Role of Procurement Services**

# Procurement Services is part of the WRPS integrated supply chain that seeks to consistently acquire the highest quality and best value of construction, services and products.

- Acquire construction, products and services...
  - at competitive prices.
  - in a timely manner (delivery).
  - by qualified suppliers or subcontractors.
  - (many items/construction are quality level work with required quality assurance clauses)
- Backed by a sound contract that reflects safety, quality & environmental standards.
  - legally enforceable.
  - include appropriate flow-down prime contract requirements.

Only department in WRPS who can commit funds by awarding contracts.



- About Bechtel WTP: Bechtel National, Inc. (BNI) is designing, constructing, and commissioning the world's largest radioactive waste treatment plant for the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE). When complete, the Hanford Tank Waste Treatment and Immobilization Plant, also known as the Vit Plant, will process and stabilize million gallons of radioactive and chemical waste currently stored at the Hanford Site.
- Vitrification: Vitrification is accomplished by mixing waste from underground tanks with glass-forming materials in high-temperature melters.
- Mission: Deliver a Waste Treatment Plant that will safely process Hanford Tank Waste in accordance with Department of Energy requirements.



## WTP (Vit Plant) Status



#### Current Project Status:

- Focused on vitrifying the low-activity waste in Hanford tanks first in 2023.
  - Melter 1 Heatup was initiated in October 2022.
- Progressing High-Level Waste (HLW) design, procurement and construction.

#### Lookahead:

- Initiate Melter 2 Heatup in early to mid 2023.
- Continue to progress the system design reviews for HI W.
- Award/re-start targeted HLW procurements (2023-2024) to support engineering design completion and construction.
- Long-term preservation and maintenance of HLW, Pretreatment (PT) Facility and warehouses.



## Tips for Working with BNI - WTP



- Reach out to the SBPM if interested in an opportunity and they will get you in touch with appropriate Procurement Representative.
- Make sure you are <u>registered with Bechtel</u>. In order to submit interest on opportunities and be added to a bid list you need to be registered.
- Confirm your System for Award Management (SAM) profile is up-to-date.
- Read the entire Request for Proposal carefully and make sure you don't leave anything blank and return the requested documents on time.
- Remember to only communicate with the Procurement Representative.
